I. OVERVIEW

Kibungo Hospital is Public Hospital under upgrading to National Referral Hospital. It is approximately at 100 km from Kigali in the Eastern Province, Ngoma, Kibungo sector, Karenge cell, Amahoro village near the main road Kigali-Rusumo about 5 km on the right way from Kibungo round about.

Kibungo Hospital established as a dispensary in 1932 by Government of Rwanda, it became a rural hospital in 1935. Then, it has been extension in 1984 and the second extension done in 1992 with Chinese cooperation. Its inauguration occurred in 1997 by Minister of health.
